

ShareHim Evangelistic Timeline

Activity Schedule

Pre-Work

1. Choose two weekends when you can be in the selected church for two weekends.
2. Prayerfully consult with Board and/or Elders. Explain the objectives, dates, schedule, and the importance for them to respond to the call.
3. Inform the congregation about the two evangelism-training Sabbaths.
4. Install the "Making Kingdom Friends" Power-Point programs from disk #1 onto your Windows-based computer.
5. "Watch" the "Overview" (Presentation #1) located on Disk #2.
6. Next, practice preaching the three Presentations (2, 3, 4, & 5 which you will use on the first Sabbath.
7. Download and print out Commitment cards to give out at the end of the Sabbath morning sermon.
8. Give some advanced thought to the campaign schedule you want to recommend. Specifically think about answering the six questions under point 4 for this first Sabbath afternoon.

Sabbath 1 - Morning

1. Pray
2. Review Synchronized notes & graphics for Sermon #2 (Biblical Call and Mandate).
3. Decision cards.
4. Preach and make the appeal
5. Invite all to stay for meal and afternoon training program.

Notes

Pre-Work

1. This document is based on two weekends, though you may want to do it in three.
2. Remind them the Evangelism team will be making and implementing decisions except those dealing with finances.
3. Suggest the church plan a pot-luck meal each Sabbath.
4. Soon material will be available with Apple-based software. All 5 discs contain Video Presentations. This "Timeline" will suggest when to use each presentation and the disc number it's on.
5. It is for YOUR benefit and NOT for the members.
6. IF you also want to watch video presentations of these topics before you preach them they are: #2 (Biblical Call & Mandate) is on Disk 3. #3 (Intro. To ShareHim) is on Disk 3. #4 (Building Kingdom Friends) is on Disk 4. And #5 (Networking and Evangelism Cycle) is on Disk 4.
7. To download: a) go to: www.sharehim.org. b) Select "Resources," c) at bottom of 3rd section (titled "Sermon Order, Decision Cards, etc) select "Team Member Commitment Cards." First page is English, second is Spanish. Print out your choice. Duplicate and cut-up.
8. How many reaping events per year are you going to recommend. Hopefully, not be less than 2 or more than 4. Also, how many weeks between the close of the "get acquainted" event and the beginning of the reaping event (or campaign). We suggest 1-2 weeks at the most.

Sabbath 1 - Morning

2. Test the laptop & projector before beginning.
3. Give Decision cards, pens/pencils (and instructions for distribution) to deacons
4. Reduce preliminaries. Allow 45 min. for sermon. Begin meeting no later than 1:45pm.
5. Some who did not respond may stay.

Activity Schedule

Sabbath 1 - Afternoon

1. 1:45 - 2:45 Use Presentation #3 (Introduction to ShareHim).
2. 3:00 - 3:45 Use Presentation #4 (Building Kingdom Friends). Distribute Prayer and Friendship Booklets, followed by a 15 min break.
3. 4:00 - 5:00 (No break at the end of this section.) Use Presentation #5 (Networking and the Evangelistic Cycle).
4. 5:00 - 6:00 Now the Pastor and Team shifts from teacher/student mode to team & decision-making mode. This team begins making "big-picture" plans which will be planned and implemented by the pastor and the evangelistic team.

1. Option 1: Show "The Gospel and Evangelism."

Sabbath 1 - Afternoon

1. This is an overview designed to create awareness of the elements of a congregation focused on church growth. (15 min break)
2. Be sure to emphasize a) Praying out-loud, every day, by name for a friend, and b) spending time with each friend, documenting in the P&F Booklet (or iPhone/Android App) the each activity and date, c) telling the "stories" in SS Class each week, and d) pastoral interviews most Sabbaths. This is THE SECRET! Tell how much fun it is! If the dream dies it will be a failure in this section! Story-telling keeps the dream alive!
3. Previous section deals with one-on-one, interpersonal relationships. This moves into: a) the why and how of developing complex relationships, and b) Linking these with regularly-scheduled Reaping Activities.
4. The agenda for this section is broken down by a series of questions. **1)** How many are willing to commit themselves to praying for, building, and documenting Kingdom Friendships? **2)** How many agree that we should plan and implement "Get-Acquainted Events" to meet eachother's new friends and follow these with Reaping Events? **3)** How many believe we should have Reaping Events every year? **4)** How many of these Reaping Events should we conduct each year? (Hopefully 2, but at least 1.) **5)** In which month(s) should these event(s) take place? (Choose the month(s) and the opening weekend of each.) **6)** How many weeks should separate the close of the "Get Acquainted Activity" and the beginning of the Reaping Event?

Pastor, you can now register the campaign dates on the ShareHim website. Later, you can decide the number of venues and select one or more speakers for each venue.

Sabbath 2 - Morning

1. Set up projection equipment so the members can see the sermon. It is the first sermon on Disk #5. On another occasion, apart from the training schedule, you may want to show "Eternity's Detour." It is the 2nd sermon on Disk #5.

Sabbath 2 - Afternoon

1. Afternoon Overview.
2. 1:45 - 2:30 The Pastor should deliver Presentation #6 (Preparing to Preach)
- 3a. 2:30 - 4:15 The Pastor should deliver Presentation #7 (The Do's and Don'ts of Preaching).
- 3b. Then, the Pastor moves right into Presentation #8 which is a video demonstrating a practice-preaching session.
4. 4:30 - 6:00 The Pastor leads out in a Practice Preaching Session similar to the one demonstrated in the previous section.
5. 6:00 - The pastor sets up one or more laptops, connected to the internet, so each of the team members can register on the ShareHim website.
6. What happens next?

Sabbath 2 - Afternoon

1. The afternoon's objective is to help each team member learn by doing, that he/she can be used by God to share His message of salvation in the context of God's prophetic message.

- 3a. This Presentation has several video clips. At the close of each the pastor asks the team to identify the most common mistakes that were demonstrated while the pastor sees on the laptop screen the mistakes that the speaker intended to demonstrate.
- 3b. The pastor and the team watch a demonstration practice-preaching session and learn what to expect from the pastor and what is expected from them in the next session.
4. We suggest the pastor set up the laptop in the "clone mode" in which speaker's notes and audience graphics appear on the same screen. While the size of the text is smaller this setup makes it possible for the students who will be practice-preaching next can see how the current speaker is handling the gaps in the sentences.
5. How to register? a) Set each computer up with an internet connection, b) Go to: www.sharehim.org c) Click on "Application Form" d) Select "Homeland," e) Select "Conference staff or pastor," f) Select your Conference, g) The Application Form appears, h) Complete the form. Should be intuitive. Comments: If they don't have an email address, they'll need to borrow one - but notify the person who owns it since they will receive a few but vital messages. Be sure each person writes his/her Password! When they're finished, click "Apply."
6. The pastor of the applicant's home church will instantly receive an email asking if the applicant is a member in good standing. The pastor makes the decision to approve or not. Approved applicants appear on the list of approved lay-evangelists, available to be used in the entire conference.

Follow-Up

1. Presumably the pastor set up campaign dates for the church at the close of the first training Sabbath. If so, now the pastor can record the number of venues where meetings will take place, and then link one or more speakers with each venue. If the opening date of the Campaign is less than a year out, ShareHim will automatically send each speaker his/her sermon material.

If the pastor has not yet set up the reaping event schedule, this should be done now, and then match the speakers to the venues.

2. **STORIES!** a) Urge each person to report in his/her SS Class the activities they did last week which they recorded in their Prayer and Friendship booklet. b) Pastor, select a person and interview them from the pulpit.

Meet with your team to finalize:

REAPING

- a) How many reaping-event sites will run concurrently, b) At who's home (or other venue) each group will meet, c) which team members will bring their friends to which site, d) What is the topic sequence at each site, e) Who will be the speakers for each site, f) When the joint meeting will begin at the church and for how many nights, g) Will there be a Baptismal (or Advanced Bible Study), and if so, when and where will it take place, and who will lead out in it?

GET ACQUAINTED EVENTS

- a) With the team decide what pre-campaign activities you're going to do? b) When and where it/they will take place? c) Who will do what?

3. Pastor, please record: Pre-Campaign event. Be sure you or each speaker record the statistics of each campaign, stories, pictures, etc. on the ShareHim website so these will be available to communication's.
